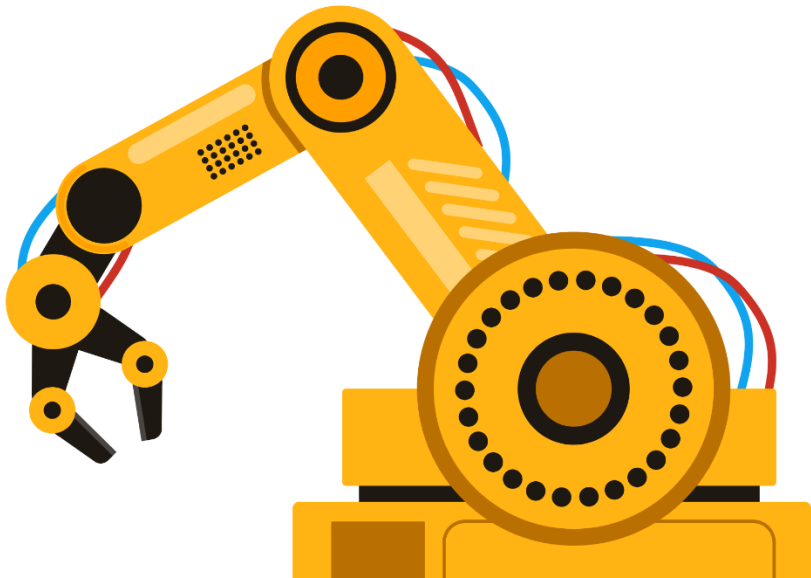


Spring Forward Professional Development Day Registration



Epilepsy is one of the most common neurological diseases worldwide, affecting around 50 million people of all ages




Did You Know?
